

Conduction of “Pig Health Camp and Awareness Program” under Tribal Sub Plan program of ICAR-National Research Center on Pig, Rani, Guwahati, Assam

A dual program on “Pig Health Camp and Awareness Program” under Tribal Sub Plan (TSP) was organized by ICAR-National Research Center on Pig, Rani, Guwahati, Assam in collaboration with All Bodoland Farmer’s Association, Baksa, Assam and Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Department, Nalbari respectively on 28-02-2020. Programme was coordinated by the group of Scientists from different disciplines of the Institute. This programme was organized to sensitize knowledge and skill among Tribal pig farmers of Nalbari and Baksa district of Assam for doubling their income by increasing the productivity of animals.

A total 300 doses of Classical Swine Fever Vaccine, 300 doses of antihelmintic, 200 doses ointment, 100 kg mineral mixture and common pig medicines were distributed among 200 number of tribal pig farmers in these two district of Assam.

Scientists also visited individual pig farm in those localities and were provided advisory services to 10 progressive pig farms of Nalbari and Baksa district of Assam.
